
Year 2 – Tennis Festival

Now you might be asking what Railway 200 is, it's set to be a nation-wide celebration of the 200th anniversary of the birth of modern railways which originally began at the Stockton and Darlington Railway.

The main rule of the competition is the poster must be designed **in felt tip pen.** This competition will give pupils a chance to learn about a few different subjects depending on your preference. It could be railway 200, railways or transport in general, or the chance to study the history of poster design and the encouragement of visiting the seaside for a holiday.

Entries can be handed into school no later than Friday 16th May.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal through the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.

Eligible children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) are also entitled to Free School Meals.

To find out if your child is eligible for Free School Meals apply through Devon County Council's <u>Citizens Portal</u>. If your application is successful, please send proof of eligibility to the school office (admin@landkey-primary.devon.sch.uk).

School Meals cost £2.50 per meal. Our preferred method of payment is via MCAS (the My Child At School Parent Portal). Meals must be paid for in advance or on the day the meal is taken. Please do not allow your child's dinner account to become overdrawn. We may ask you to provide packed lunch for your child whilst overdrawn accounts are cleared.


